Assessment

You will complete five assessments in total: a case study; work based coursework, management report and a 24 hour assessment which places you under time pressure to complete a series of examination type questions.

Duration of Programme

Normally Nine months.

Entry Requirements

Entry to the Diploma is available for all those who can demonstrate that they will benefit from it. Candidates should be able to demonstrate the ability to learn at this level through the possession of prior qualifications or experience. The programme is however designed to meet the needs of middle managers and as such demands the ability to relate learning to the workplace. Candidates will therefore normally be practicing managers or have recent relevant experience.

Candidates should have English ability equivalent to an IELTS score of 6.0.
